BREAKFAST

Before English breakfast had its name, the early tea planters enjoyed its full-bodied flavours in Ceylon. Hand-picked in the Dimbula Valley.

AFTERNOON

The traditional afternoon tea of cakes and sandwiches is best taken with a bright & fragrant tea. Ideal on its own or with a splash of milk.

EARL GREY

The most aristocratic of teas is infused with the unmistakable aroma of bergamot. Our Earl Grey is hand-picked and infused with a drop of bergamot oil.

GREEN

Grown on the high peaks and hand-plucked to fully satisfy the green tea connoisseur. A large leaf tea, curled and pan heated to produce a light mellow brew.

CEYLON CHAI CINNAMON

A spicy taste with hints of cinnamon, this tea is made using natural Ceylon spices, which are then carefully married with high grown tea to give a brew that is both reviving & calming.

APPLE CINNAMON

Artful blend of black tea, apple pieces, hibiscus, marigold, liquorice and Ceylon Cinnamon gives your cuppa a fruity and spicy twist.

WALDEMAR ROASTED OOLONG

Grown at 6000ft on Waldemar estate, this Oolong is the perfect autumnal brew. The Deep roasting process produces a rich and autumnal tea with fragrant notes of poached pears with sweet nutty finish.

LOVERS LEAP ESTATE – NUWARA ELIYA, CEYLON

The estate gets its name from two lovers who leapt to their fate. Famous for being the only tea that was served at the Queen's Diamond Jubilee. Best enjoyed on its own, or with a slice of lemon.

ST. JAMES ESTATE

St James is found in the prized Malwatte Valley of the Uva region. The topography of the estate combined with the seasonal characteristics that bless the region provide a sought after tea. The cup is bright red with an enticing golden ring around the cup. The cup is aromatic with a strong bouquet with a hint of natural wintergreen, the classic characteristics of a well-made seasonal Uva.
