Peppermint

Origin: Germany

Taste: Fresh, clean and strong peppermint.

Only the highest quality leaves are used in our peppermint infusion. Renowned for its digestive properties, peppermint is also known to have a calming effect.

Chamomile whole flower

Origin: Croatia

Taste: Honey like but with a more intense taste than the usual product.

Rooibos or Red Bush

Origin: South Africa, Cape Province.

Taste: Soft, sweet and fruity.

Although first exported in the nineteenth century, native South Africans produced tea from the red bush long before Europeans. The branches of the shrub were dried in the sun and then cut into very small pieces from which tea was made.

Earl Grey Supreme

Origin: Sri Lanka.

Taste: Full bodied, rich and fragrant, just as it should be. It is strong enough to have with milk but we recommend you try it without. This Earl Grey is exceptional and is blended with the finest Italian Bergamot oil.

Assam Mangalam

Origin: Assam, India.

Taste: This is a connoisseur tea with a bright rich cup, spicy and deliciously malty. This single Estate tea is arguably the finest Assam available today.

Darjeeling Supreme

Origin: Darjeeling, India.

Taste: Fresh and fruity.

Known as the champagne of teas this Darjeeling is a first flush (first plucking). It is stronger in body and astringency than the less expensive second flush. Normally drunk without milk.

Decaffeinated Assam Tea

Origin: Kenya Highlands.

Taste: This is a bright tea with full taste for those who wish to avoid caffeine.

Our decaffeinated tea is produced without chemicals by using the Co2 method. The Co2 method uses Co2 gas rather than chemicals to remove the caffeine as not to leave any chemical traces on the tea.

Classic Chai

Origin: Sumatra

Taste: Full of spices and the tastes from the East.

Ingredients are black tea, cardamom, aniseed, cinnamon, ginger, black pepper, cloves, chicory root and natural flavouring.

Lapsang Souchong

Origin: Taiwan. (Formosa)

Taste: Our Lapsang Souchong has a strong and bold smoky flavour.

It is produced from larger more mature leaves which are then dried, withered and smoked over pine embers. This is Lapsang Souchong as it should be.

Green Curve

Origin: China, Wu Lu Mountain, Jiangxi region.

Taste: This premium quality green tea is elegant, softly tart with a smooth, sweet touch.

Jasmine Chun Hao

Origin: South East China, Fujian Province.

Taste: Jasmine Chun Hao has a full bodied clean and fresh taste, great with any food.

A wonderful Jasmine tea which has been carefully scented five times with Jasmine flowers and contains a high proportion of silver buds.

Moroccan Mint

Origin: China and Morocco.

Taste: Refreshing, revitalising with spearmint taste.

This famous green tea is the much loved blend of pinhead gunpowder green tea and Moroccan nana mint (spearmint). Our Moroccan Mint contains only the highest quality ingredients.

Winchester breakfast extra strong

Origin: Assam, India and Sri Lanka high-grown.

A Brief History of Cocktails

Cocktail is a strange, rather crude word for such an elegant drink. It is derived from the eighteenth century slang term for a docked tail, first applied to a horses of mixed breed and then to a nag on a racecourse. A combination of the societies that the drinks were most popular with, along with the notion of mixed breeding, must have led to the word being applied to alcoholic recipes.

The first cocktails originated in England at the height of the Victorian era. When the English entertained at home they stayed faithful to the grape, but in Gentlemen's clubs they started to experiment with drinks such as the Sherry Cobbler, which was a mixture of Medium Sherry, Curacao, Syrup and Grenadine. They were normally served in sporting cups that the Gentlemen had won.

Cocktails became popular in the US at the time of Prohibition, because to hide alcohol from the police raids the gangsters had to change the taste of the alcohol by mixing it with any type of liquid that they could get their hands on. So the barmen in the speakeasies had the difficult task of making tasty drinks from the alcohol supplies they were given. This inspired travel agents into starting a new profitable trade in "wet weekends" to Cuba where people were allowed to drink freely and drinks like the Cuba Libre were invented.

Whilst this was happening in the US, across Europe the cocktail hour was in full swing, where drinks like Bloody Mary and the Side Car were invented in France.

Eventually when prohibition was lifted in the US the very creative barmen from the speakeasies got jobs in some of the top hotels and bars around the world and began to create drinks like the Martinis, Gin Fizz, Americano, Tom Collins and Manhattan.
